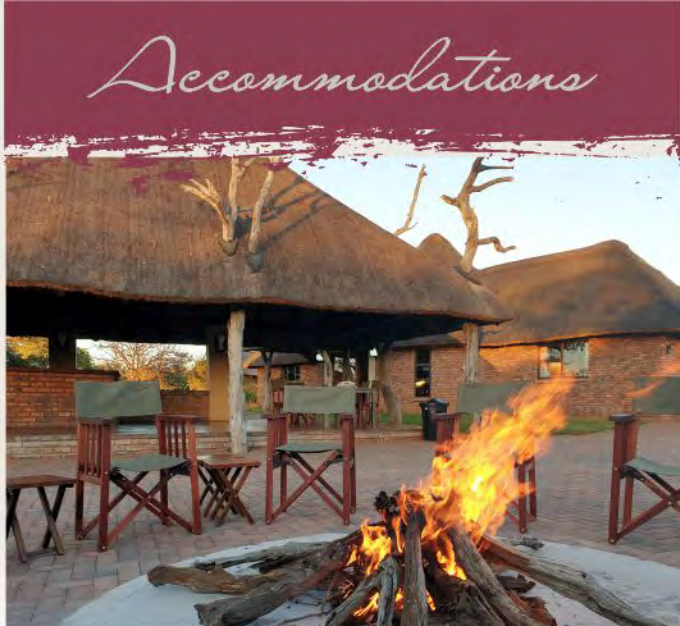

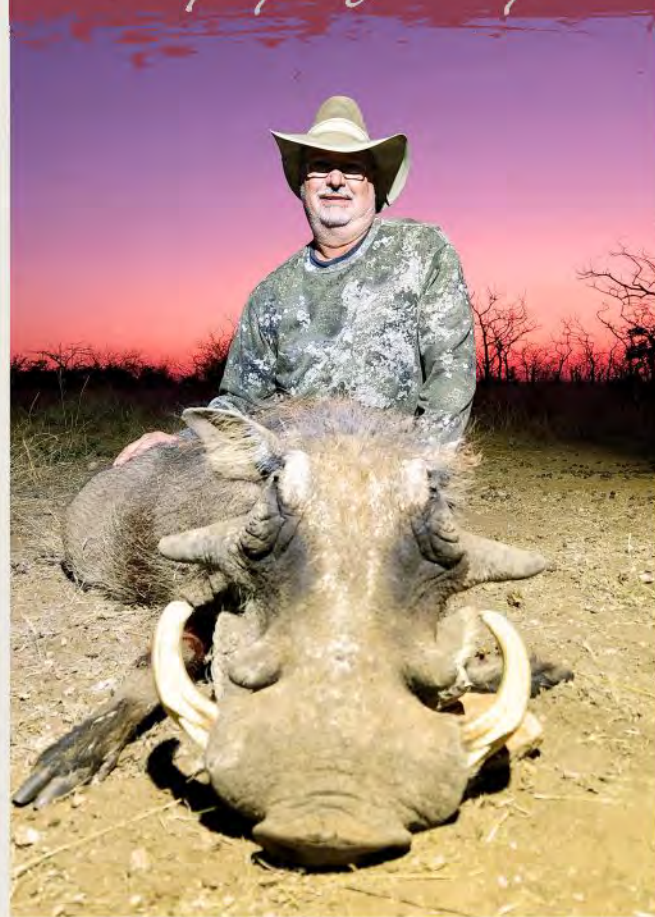

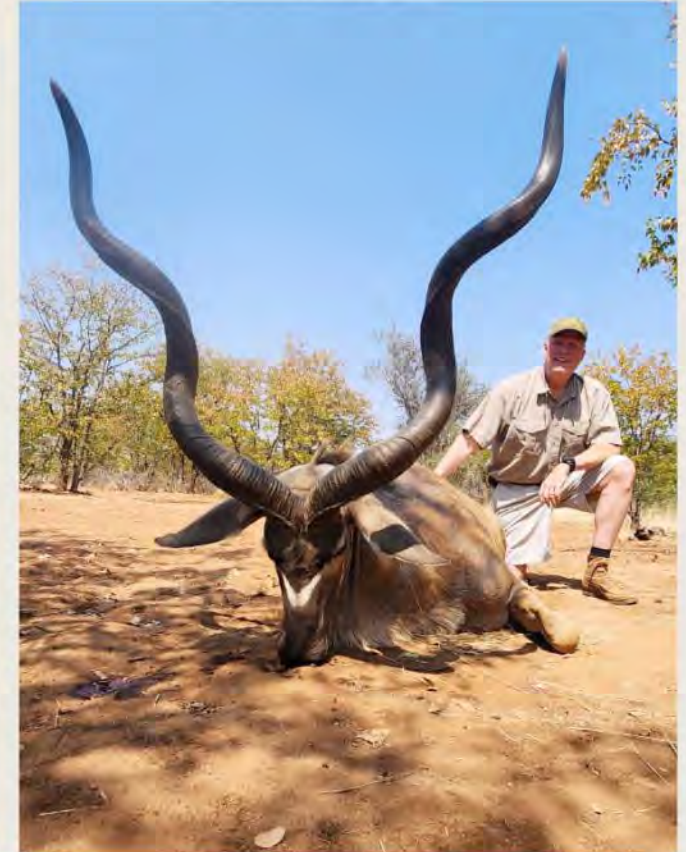

## Frequently Asked Questions : Answers



1. Laundries – we do laundry daily – don't bring too many clothes. Sunblock is necessary if hunting during February, March, April, September & October.
2. Wine, beer & soft drinks are included - if any other preferred (Whisky, Brandy, Vodka etc.) Please buy at airport or asked the PH to stop at a local store on the way to the camp.
3. We do have WI-FI at certain camps but dependant on the cell signal quality
4. The electrical power is AC 220v 50Hz. Plug adapters are available in the camp. Your equipment need to be compatible for 220v if not, please bring a converter with.
5. No vaccinations are required to enter South Africa only recommended. Malaria is the only "concern" in our area and only maybe during our summer months (raining season) Hunting take place mainly during our winter.
6. Payments -Specials & Packages -25% deposit is payable within 14 days to reserve the booking. The outstanding amount is payable in cash or to be wire transferred in our account within 5 days after leaving camp. Credit card facilities are available at a surcharge of 3% (Master & Visa only) No payments required if the hunt was bought at donation auctions.
7. Our local taxidermist (Trophy Solutions Africa [www.trophy-care.com](http://www.trophy-care.com)) will do the raw preparation to export the trophies and is also willing to mount your trophies. If you prefer your trophies to be completed in the US, please provide taxidermy details
8. Permits (tags) We need to apply for special permits (tags) at least 2 weeks prior to your arrival in South Africa if you are interested in harvesting any animals that are listed with CITES – Roans, Crocodiles, Lions, Baboons, Monkeys small cats etc. Please send a copy of your passport with the request.

## Tariffs Include

- Liquor and beverages served in camp (wine, beer & soft drinks).
- Laundry.
- Full-time service of an experienced Professional Hunter.
- Trained staff, trackers and skinners.
- Field preparation of trophies.
- All transport within the hunting areas.
- All hunting licenses.
- Pick up and drop off at Intl. Airport closest to the area in which you are going to hunt.

## Tariffs Exclude

- Gratuities - recommended tips PH \$100-\$150 per day, Tracker \$25 per day, Kitchen staff \$40 - \$50 per day, Skinner \$15 per day
- International and domestic flights.
- Additional animals and license fees.
- Traveling days (traveling days are considered non-hunting days at \$180 per person per day).
- Trophy fees on animals shot or wounded.
- Rifle hire (Firearms may be rented at \$40 per day. Ammunition is available at cost.)
- Dipping, packing, taxidermy and shipping.
- Air charters and accommodations before and after the safari.
- Tips for staff, telephone calls and curio purchases.

# Tours

**K**rugers National Park, in northeastern South Africa, is one of Africa's largest game reserves. Its high density of wild animals includes the Big 5: lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants and buffalos. Hundreds of other mammals make their home here, as do diverse bird species such as vultures, eagles and storks. Mountains, bush plains and tropical forests are all part of the landscape.

**Duration:** 2 Nights\* / 3 Days

**Meals:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided

## Day 1

After breakfast at the hunting camp we travel via Louis Trichardt and Venda known as the "Land of Legends" to the park and spend the rest of the day in the park where we also overnight.

Other activities: Evening game drive

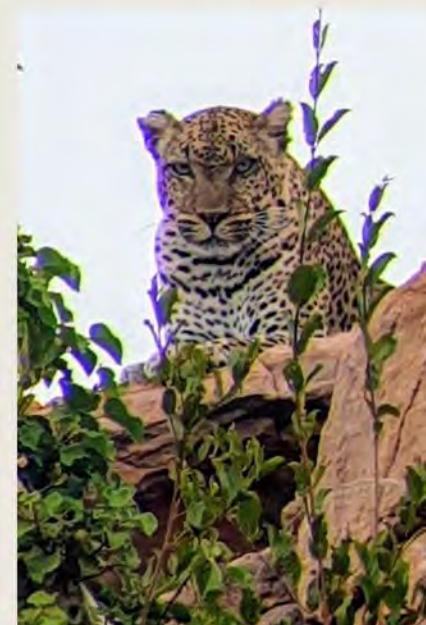
